### Course details

By the end of Level 2, French students should be able to take part in discussions with French speakers, understand much of what is said and contribute relevant comments. They share information and justify their ideas and opinions in different situations. Students read a range of authentic materials and write a variety of texts to convey information in genuine contexts. They also prepare and deliver a two minute speech in French. Students study the following themes: identities, experiences and social organisation. They also have regular conversation practice with our French language assistant to help develop their speaking and listening skills.
